

## **Effective: Thursday, May 30, 2019**

### **Category 2 & 3 OPEN FIRES PROHIBITED**

Category 2 & 3 Open Fires (Burn barrels, backyard burning, incinerators, burn piles, fireworks, sky lanterns, etc.) are **NOT** permitted in the Deep Bay Improvement District.

Small campfires used for cooking, heating, or ceremonial purposes are allowed, subject to the following:

- Fire is no larger than 1/2 meter by 1/2 meter in size
- Only clean, dry wood can be used, no branches or yard waste
- A responsible person must be in attendance of the fire at all times, have a hand tool or at least 8 litres of water available to properly extinguish the fire.
- The fire must be extinguished fully (ashes are cold to the touch) when done/before leaving the area.
- Fire must be away from combustible materials
- Be considerate of neighbours when planning a campfire.

Please be aware that forest conditions are extremely dry.
