

DEEP BAY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 230

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund of four hundred and fifty one thousand, eight hundred and seventy four dollars (\$451,874) as at December 21, 2016, which amount has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at December 31, 2015	\$ 304,754
Add: Additions to fund including interest earnings for current year to date	\$ 149,535
Deduct: Previously authorized disbursements for current year to date	\$ 2,415
Balance in Reserve Fund as at December 21, 2016	\$ 451,874

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No. 205 (Deep Bay Improvement District's Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw) for the purpose of upgrading, replacement or renewal of existing works

The Trustees of the Deep Bay Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund to be expended on upgrades and replacement works for Well #5.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated will be specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance will be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "2016 Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund Disbursement Bylaw".
