Oops! Correction to toilet usage numbers:

Please note that the figures that were published in the November mail out were incorrect. The conversion calculation was incorrect and therefore the usage and water savings were overstated. By replacing your old toilets with a low flow or dual flush you can still see a reduction in your quarterly water use of up to 15 cubic meters.



We do have some additional copies of the RDN Toilet Replacement Rebate Program application in the office if you need one.

Electronic Payment Update:

Please note that due to the introduction of monthly fees we will no longer be accepting electronic payments from Scotia Bank. This change is effective February 28, 2010. While we regret having to do this, the change will only affect 3% of our ratepayers. The board does not feel justified increasing rates to all our ratepayers for these charges. Electronic banking will continue to be available for all Credit Unions, HSBC, Bank of Montreal and CIBC.
