Carsten Jensen, Architect, working closely with the Building Renewal Committee members, has completed the conceptual design of the new fire hall addition. Carsten has experience with pre-fabricated metal structures which, after exhaustive research, the Committee determined would be the most cost effective building option.

The proposed building will be both efficient and economical and has been designed to meet long-term fire protection and emergency response needs of the DBID residents and area.

How do you compare?

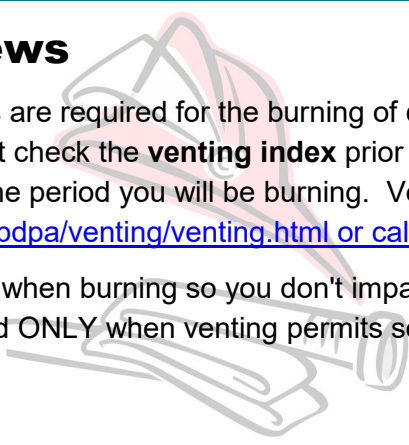
Some comparison numbers for this invoice period:

- 8% of all households used no water
- 76% of all households used less than 40 m³
- 14% of all households used between 40 and 74 m³
- 1% of all households used between 75 and 100 m³
- 1% of all households used over 100 m³

Fire Department News

Open Burning Reminder: Permits are required for the burning of **dry yard waste** effective April 15th and conditions apply: you must check the **venting index** prior to commencing your burn. Venting index must be "good" for the period you will be burning. Venting index information available at: <http://www.env.gov.bc.ca/epd/epdpa/venting/venting.html> or call 1-888-281-2992.

Be considerate of your neighbours when burning so you don't impact their daily routine or health. Burn materials hot, infrequently and **ONLY** when venting permits so the smoke goes straight up.
