TAX DEDUCTIBLE DONATIONS

The Deep Bay Improvement District (DBID) has applied for and received registration as a "Qualified Donee" as determined by Canada Revenue Agency.

As a qualified donee, DBID is eligible to receive gifts from registered charities and to issue official receipts for gifts received. Within specified limits (as per the *Income Tax Act*) and if supported by official receipts, individual taxpayers may claim a credit against taxes payable, and corporations may claim a deduction in computing taxable income, for the eligible amount of a gift made to a qualified donee.

Donations in support of our new fire hall will go directly to the Building Renewal Fund. If you wish to donate for some specific item, please contact the Fire Department for suggestions as to what may be needed.
