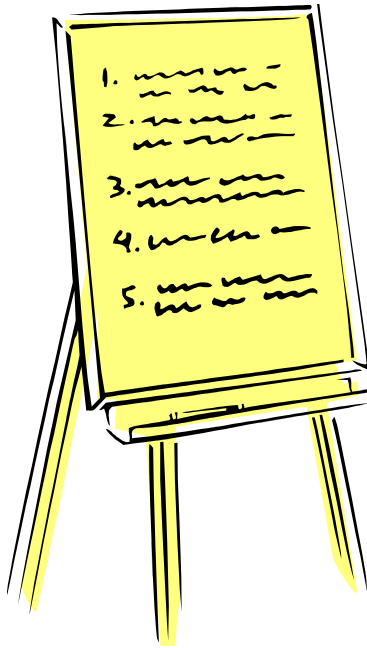

### **How do you compare?**

Some comparison numbers for this invoice period:

# Fire Department News

**Open Burning Reminder:** Burning of **dry yard waste** is permitted without a permit until April 15<sup>th</sup> but conditions apply: you must check the **venting index** prior to commencing your burn. Venting index must be "good" for the period you will be burning. Venting index information available at: <http://www.env.gov.bc.ca/epd/epdpa/venting/venting.html> or call 1-888-281-2992.

Be considerate of your neighbours when burning so you don't impact their daily routine or health. Burn materials hot, infrequently and **ONLY** when venting permits so the smoke goes straight up.
