Watering Restrictions

Fire Department News

REMINDER: Permits are required for open burning from April 16 – October 14 inclusive.

It is expected that open burning (category 2 & 3) will be closed shortly – watch the signs at the top of Gainsberg & Jamieson Road or call 250-757-2030 for more information.

If a total ban is imposed, this will include campfires, tiki torches and fireworks.

Updated Fire Regulations Bylaw

Campfires (no larger than .5 meter x .5 meter and used for recreational purposes) are permissible at any time without a permit unless a total burn ban has been implemented.

Open Burning: no material other than *low moisture content garden refuse* may be burned.

Category 2 fires (no larger than 2 meters high x 3 meters wide) do not require a permit from Oct 15 – Apr 15 unless proclaimed otherwise by the fire chief.

Category 3 fires (larger than 2 meters high by 3 meters wide) require a permit at all times.

Remember to check the Venting Index: burning must not be initiated unless the Environment Canada Ventilation Index is forecast as “good” for the burning period.

- ◆ **Cheque or Cash** - in person at the office. Cheques can also be mailed - please do not mail cash.

Some comparison numbers for this invoice period:

3% of all households used no water

45% of all households used less than 40 m³

28% of all households used between 40 and 74 m³

8% of all households used between 75 and 100 m³

16% of all households used over 100 m³
