Fire Hall Renewal Project Update

Once a workable, preliminary budget is finalized, a public meeting will be announced to further discuss the proposed project, budget numbers and tax implications.

How do you compare?

Some comparison numbers for this invoice period:

8% of all households used no water

74% of all households used less than 40 m³

14% of all households used between 40 and 74 $\,\mathrm{m}^3$

2% of all households used between 75 and 100 m³

Fire Department News

REMINDER: Permits are required for all Category 2 & 3 open burning from April 16 – October 14 inclusive

Fire Regulations:

Campfires (no large than .5 meter x .5 meter and used for recreational purposes) are permissible at any time without a permit unless a total burn ban has been implemented.

Open Burning: no material other than *low* moisture content garden refuse may be burned. Category 2 fires (no larger than 2 meters high x 3 meters wide) do not require a permit from Oct 15 – Apr 15 unless proclaimed otherwise by the fire chief.

Category 3 fires (larger than 2 meters high by 3 meters wide) require a permit at all times.

Remember to check the Venting Index: burning must not be initiated unless the Environment Canada Ventilation Index is forecast as "good" for the burning period. Prior to burning check the venting index at:
