Fire Department News

TOTAL BURN BAN NOW IN EFFECT

Effective Thursday, July 6 and until further notice, all open fires - including campfires – are banned in the Deep Bay Improvement District.

The ban applies to open fires of any size, campfires, fireworks, firecrackers, sky lanterns, tiki torches and burning barrels. This ban has been implemented by the Deep Bay Fire Chief in conjunction with the ban implemented by the Coastal Fire Centre covering Vancouver Island and the South Coast.

***40% of BC wildfires are human-caused and therefore preventable.
Keeping our community safe is everyone's responsibility.***

If you see a fire, call 911 to have the fire department dispatched to investigate.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

- ◆ Pre Authorized Payment (PAP) Plan - applications available from the office and on the website. **PAP Plan is available for all financial institutions.**
- ◆ On-line/Telephone banking - set up for most financial institutions (not available for HSBC, National or RBC).
- ◆ Cheque or Cash - in person at the office. Cheques can also be mailed - please do not mail cash.

Some comparison numbers for this invoice period:

30% of all households used between 40 and 74 m³

8% of all households used between 75 and 100 m³

13% of all households used over 100 m³
