

DEEP BAY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 259

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund of one million three hundred and fifteen thousand, three hundred and twenty dollars (\$1,315,320) as at July 18, 2024, which amount has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at December 31, 2023	\$ 1,218,107
Add: Additions to fund including interest earnings for current year to date	\$ 97,213
Deduct: Previously authorized disbursements for current year to date	\$ 0
Balance in Reserve Fund as at July 18, 2024	\$ 1,315,320

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No. 205 (Deep Bay Improvement District's Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw) for the purpose of upgrading, replacement or renewal of existing works.

The Trustees of the Deep Bay Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of eighty-eight thousand seven hundred dollars (\$88,700) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Renewal Reserve Fund to be expended on engineering and design services, including, design, environmental assessment, archaeological review and tender management for the Thompson Clarke West Emergency Watermain replacement project.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated will be specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance will be returned to the credit of said Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw No. 259 – 2024 Capital Works – Thompson Clarke West Emergency Watermain Replacement – Engineering and Design – Renewal Reserve Fund Disbursement Bylaw".


