BYLAW NO. 262

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 223, being the “Fire Regulations Bylaw”

The Trustees of the Deep Bay Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the improvement district’s Bylaw No. 223 passed by the Trustees on the 16th day of September 2015 is hereby amended by:

i) Deleting Section 32, including the heading, and replacing it with the following:

Restriction, Fires in the “Open Air”

32.


- a. “Category 2 Open Fire” and “Category 3 Open Fire” burns require a permit at all times.
- b. All category “Category 2 Open Fire” and “Category 3 Open Fire” permits will be valid from the issue date for a maximum of 30 days, at the discretion of the issuer.

ii) Renumbering all sections accordingly

2. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Bylaw No. 262 – Fire Regulations Amendments Bylaw, 2024”.




