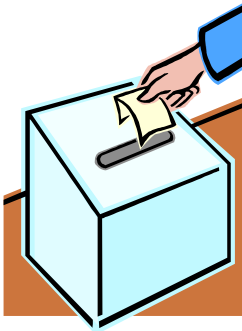
Trustee positions to be filled:

## Open Burning Information

**Campfires are allowed without permit, all other open burning requires a permit, YEAR ROUND. Check the signs at the top of Jamieson and Gainsberg Roads for updated information.**

**Current burn ban information will be posted on the website.  
Please call the DBID office if you have any questions regarding fire permits.**

Please be considerate of your neighbours when burning so you don't impact their daily routine or health. Burn materials hot, infrequently and ONLY when venting permits so the smoke goes straight up.
